Commonwealth Games Coins

Public response to this series has been extremely disappointing. The collection of twelve coins did not generate the interest which had been anticipated, and there is no doubt that interest during the immediate period of the Games was adversely affected by the late decision of several Commonwealth countries not to participate. The coins will remain on sale for a further period, though it is likely that any further sales will be relatively modest.

We are extremely sorry that the coins were not better received. As you will be aware, the Royal Mint self-financed the project, including costs for designs and master tools, and Jersey's liability was limited to coins which you purchased for local sale.

I confirm that we will be paying a royalty of 5% of retail prices to the Commonwealth Games Organising Committee, in addition to the 10% royalty which you are due on sales of these coins.





THE PARISH OF GROUVILLE

Details extracted from the 1981 census showed that in order of population the Parish of Grouville had the seventh largest and as such its emblem is displayed upon the reverse of the next £1 coin to be issued in the Parish Emblems series.

Eight alternate bands of silver and red form the Parish emblem and this variation has been captured in the detailed engraving of the coin. The emblem is actually known as St. Martin of Grouville and its origins date back to Louis XI of France.

The Parish of Grouville is the southernmost of the two parishes that form the east of the Island and it has many delightful features. It boasts a fine sandy beach in the Royal Bay of Grouville and at low tide a very wide area of shore is exposed to show an expanse of rocks and reefs, all of which make navigation in this area very hazardous.

The prefix 'Royal' to the Bay of Grouville was added in 1859 by command of Queen Victoria following a visit to Jersey.

In the extreme western side of the Parish is La Hougie Bie, a prehistoric burial ground. It is steeped in local history and its Neolithic tomb is said by many to be one of the finest to be found in Europe. It is of considerable interest to residents and visitors alike.

Probably the best known feature is Grouville Common - a vast area of sandy heath bordering the coast. Over the years it has been used for a variety of purposes. In the 18th century when France was the enemy the low lying common was heavily fortified and the several Martello Towers around the coastline are reminders of those far off days of anxiety and strife. In the 19th century horse races were held on the heath and these culminated in an annual carnival which was very widely supported. In time that gave way to the pursuits of golf and from early beginnings and with such players as Harry Vardon and Ted Ray, both British Open Champions, the links have become the headquarters of the Royal Jersey Golf Club.

Agriculture plays an important part in the community. A considerable number of farms are located in Grouville with the emphasis on mixed rather than specialised farming.





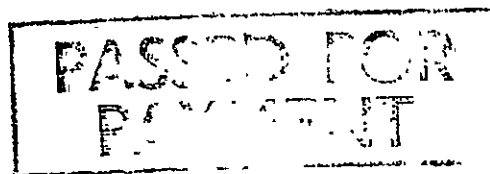

THE PARISH OF ST. PETER

The 1981 census indicated that the Parish of St. Peter had the sixth largest population in the Island and accordingly its emblem is displayed upon the reverse of the next parish coin to be issued in the Parish Emblems series.

The design of two crossed keys represents the keys of Heaven in the charge of St. Peter.

The Parish of St. Peter is unique in several ways. It is the only parish which has two coast lines - one partly in St. Aubin's Bay and the other partly in St. Ouen's Bay. Its Parish Church has the tallest spire of all the parochial churches and it is the only one to support an obstruction red light - because of its position in relation to the Airport. Ancient documents describe the Church as San Pietro in Deserto - St. Peter in the Desert - presumably the close proximity of the sand dunes was the reason for this.

Although a flying service to Jersey commenced in 1924 with aeroplanes landing on West Park sands it was not until 1937 that the States opened the Airport at St. Peter at a cost of £128,000. Initially it covered a mere 83 acres. Many extensions have been made over the years and now it is one of the busiest Airports in the British Isles.

One interesting relic of Tudor times remains in the Parish. Only six cannons made in the 16th Century by gunmakers Owens of Houndsditch are known to be in existence and one stands at the foot of Beaumont Hill.

St. Peter's Valley is a picturesque area and the National Trust's property "Le Moulin de Quetteville" is a lasting reminder of an era in Jersey's history when flour milling was a local occupation.

I confirm that the diameter of your coin will be 38.28mm, as included in the specification on the draft for the information leaflet. 38.51mm was first mentioned, as it is the standard diameter for Crown pieces with a milled edge. However, you later decided to have an incuse inscription around the edge, which results in the slightly smaller diameter. 38.28mm is the same as was used last year for your Liberation £2 coin.

When I wrote to you on 27 January with details of coins sold to the end of the year, I omitted to let you know that the gold and silver proofs for St Saviour and St Brelades have now been withdrawn from general sale. Subject to any late orders which may not have been accounted for, the figures shown on the statement represent our total sales.

In your letter dated 22nd July last, you asked to have stock figures for coins taken off sale, in case you might be able to place additional coins locally. You may like to know therefore that we are holding 10 surplus St Brelade gold proofs plus 28 St Brelade silver proofs. Assuming you are unable to make use of the gold coins, we propose, with your agreement, to have them destroyed and to use the bullion to make an equivalent quantity of St Peter gold coins for us to sell later in the year.

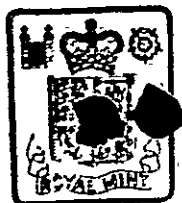

Liberation Issue

Demand for the ordinary standard 50 pence coins was lower than had been anticipated, and it is likely that we will have some 10,000 pieces surplus to requirements. Unless you would have a use for these coins, they will be destroyed shortly.
