Further to our recent telephone conversation I have investigated the matter of the royalty statement concerning the Jersey 'tickler' silver proof coin issues.

I have discussed the matter with my finance colleagues and they advise me that the total issues of silver proof coins 2,560 is overstated by ten pieces. This error has occurred due to the Royal Mint Marketing Department acting as go-between in dealings between two coin dealers. One dealer had ten such coins and the other dealer required them and therefore the Royal Mint Marketing Department fulfilled the needs of the one from the stock of the other. In error therefore the sale of ten additional pieces has been shown where as in fact it was merely a transaction between two members of our dealer network.

I would ask you to please accept my apologies for the error and we in turn thank you for pointing out the problem to us. A revised statement will be prepared and sent to you shortly.

THE JERSEY-SERIES

The new series of £1 coins from the beautiful Channel Island of Jersey began in the spring of this year and salutes the craft of shipbuilding on the island in the nineteenth century. The first in the series depicted a two-masted schooner, the Tickler, and proved so enormously popular that the silver coin very quickly sold out and only a small number of the gold remains.

The Percy Douglas

The reverse of the second coin in the series, modelled by Royal Mint engraver Robert Evans, features the Percy Douglas, a three-masted ship constructed in 1861 and named after Major General Sir Robert Percy Douglas, then Lieutenant Governor of Jersey. The Percy Douglas was built at Beaumont, Jersey, by Edward Allen but was registered in Liverpool to Thomas Hayley, to whom the ship was consigned when Edward Allen went bankrupt. Registered at 781 tons and launched on 8 August 1861, the Percy Douglas worked the China routes until 14 December 1871 when she was totally wrecked after running aground off the coast of India.

The obverse, as does Jersey's circulating coinage, bears Arnold Machin's portrait of Her Majesty Queen Elizabeth II while the island's Roman name - CAESAREA INSULA - is incorporated into the design as an incuse *edge* inscription.
