

Dear Mr Le Marquand

Many thanks for your letter dated 21st March 1991. I would like to take this opportunity to cover a few points of outstanding information as covered in our telephone conversations over the last two weeks.

1. Proposed Proof/Base Metal Set

Having investigated the costing aspects of the proposed set, it would appear that the cost of producing the Base Metal Proof coins would not be attractive to you keeping in mind your comments of having a set which would be marketed in between that of a traditional base metal set and a proof coin set. The cost of producing the proof base metal coins would be £16.95 per set, which would include reducing rings and capsules. Finally, if you consider that the quantity of 500 sets could be increased to say 1500-2000 sets then this would consequently reduce the price per set. If you require any further information on the above please do not hesitate to contact me.

2. Shipbuilding Series - Sample Coins

Again I must apologise for the lateness of these samples arriving in Jersey but as you will see from the attached fax from Circle Freight they assumed incorrectly that Jersey had moved to the U.S.A.

3. Parish Emblem Series

I am pleased to enclose the required photographs as outlined in your letter of 21.3.'91. They are all photographs of the plaster models, which on examination were far superior to the photographs of the

finished coin on file. I have also requested a copy of the booklet which featured all twelve coins which I will forward to you at a later date if you so require.

I hope the above has answered all the outstanding points and look forward to your requirements for the "Tickler" coins.

Reference your fax of 13 March, which I managed to persuade John Parker to translate, I understand the proposal is for a Base Metal Proof Set for Jersey in a Sandhill style case which presumably Jersey hold in stock and are trying to use up.

I do not think the packaging concept is a good one and in this format I would not wish to promote it to my customers. The idea of a Jersey Base Metal Proof Set per se is acceptable only if it were to be packaged in the same style of the UK Base Metal Proof Set. A proof set packaged in this latter format containing the new 5p and the Ship-building £1 with, say, an issue limit of 1500 of which 500 go to the country should be capable of being sold to the issue limit.

However, as mentioned above, if the proposal remains as presented by Jersey, then it is not a concept I would wish to market.


I have considered another alternative and would be pleased to have your comments.


